



ALCOA PEEL FOOTBALL LEAGUE INTERCHANGE STEWARD CONTROL SHEET

INSTRUCTIONS

1. There will be 2 lines 15 metres apart, marked across the boundary line at which players can be interchanged. The Steward will be stationed near to the fence between the 2 marked lines which will be situated in a central position of each ground.
2. Each competing team is to provide the Steward with a completed Team Sheet prior to the start of the match and nominate a person or persons who can request a change of reserves.
3. Once the match has started no interchange of players will be permitted without the Steward being advised of the numbers of the players being changed.
4. Changes must be effected within 3 minutes of the notification –
A) If no change is effected within the prescribed time, the elapsed time and incident must be recorded by the Steward;
B) If no change is effected within the prescribed time, a new advice of any change must be given to the Steward
5. Players eligible to interchange throughout the match must cross the boundary line at the same place within the marked lines, player off first, player on second.
6. Players leaving the arena other than through the marked lines if replaced cannot take further part in the match (see below). In the event of any further player entering the arena other than through the marked lines his club will incur a \$50 fine.
7. If a player become ineligible to further participate in the remainder of a match both stewards are to note the time, circumstances and the player's team and [playing number on the control sheet either in the special comments or in the time in/out section. Both stewards are to advise the relative Club Official/s and note the time and name of the Official who has been advised on the Stewards Control Sheet. If the ineligible player returns to the playing arena after all the above requirements have been completed, then By-Law 9(c) of the Peel Football League Inc. Constitution, Rules and Regulations states;
'Any club which plays a player who is ineligible to play with such Club or who is disqualified from playing under these rules shall forfeit the match in which such player takes part and the opposing Club shall be declared the winner of the match. The total points scored by both clubs shall count in determining percentages.'
8. Players who are carried from the arena through the marked lines provided the replacement player does not go onto the field until the injured player is over the boundary can participate later if desired. Players who are not returning to participate in the remainder of a match must have their player's numbers recorded with the steward.
9. If a player is badly injured and his team wishes him replaced prior to his being removed from the playing arena, the steward must be notified. The injured player is not permitted to take any further part in the match.
10. Teams interchanging reserves during the intervals when the interchange players are not required to cross the marked lines must advise the steward of such changes before the match commences.
11. Should the steward observe the teams being lined up for the purpose of a count (Law 3.3) he should attend to assist the Field Umpire if required.
12. Breaches of any of these Instructions must be noted in the Special Comments sections on the control sheet.
13. After the match the Steward is to lodge the control sheet with the Field umpire in the umpire's room for dispatch to the APFL Inc. Office.
